Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 199 dated 14.04.2018, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad, under Sections 341, 307, 506, 147, 148, 149 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the FIR, the present petitioner, who was one of the pillion riders on the motor-cycle, was armed with a countrymade pistol and he fired a shot on the head of Sonu.

He is the main accused. There is every chance of tampering with the evidence, if the petitioner is released on bail.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
