Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. i.e. inherent powers with following prayer:-

“Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. with prayer for directing the respondents to inquire the matter in the representation (complaint) as Annexure P-1 and take action in accordance with law.

It is also prayed that status report of the action taken or investigation progress in the complaint may kindly be sought from respondent No.2.

Any other order or direction as this Hon'ble High Court deem appropriate may also kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner in the interest of justice.”

In the considered view of this Court, looking into the facts and circumstances of the present case, petitioner has effective remedies before the superior police officers as also before the Judicial Magistrate. Hence, relegated to the remedy available under the law.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
