ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.31 dated 22.02.2019 under Sections 406/420IPC, registered at Police Station Dandh, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that the complainant had paid a sum of Rs. 12,000/- to the petitioner to pursue the computer course. He also contends that out of the total sum of Rs. 12,000/-, the petitioner had refunded an amount of Rs. 9,000/- to the complainant after deducting the expenses, as the complainant had expressed his inability to pursue the course. He further contends that the petitioner has no concern with the decree, which is alleged to have been obtained by the complainant from a University in Punjab. The petitioner is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

This Court, by order dated 01.05.2019, had directed the petitioner

to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the

event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Krishan Lal, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 01.05.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
