The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 29.10.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M No. 13582 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Having heard learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 17.02.2018 (Annexure P-2) and do the needful, if required.”

Reply dated 05.09.2019 was filed by way of affidavit of Ms. Astha Modi, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra, annexing order dated 05.08.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against order dated 05.08.2019.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
