occasions. She never made any complaint in respect of that beating or threat by the private respondents previously.

The contents of the representation dated 22.04.2019 (Annexure P-7) have been perused wherein it is mentioned that private respondents are opposed to the marriage, whereas it is not disputed by petitioner No.1 that the parents are not even aware of the alleged marriage between them. Petitioner No.1 is unable to disclose any mode and manner of threat allegedly extended by private respondents.

Resultantly, no case is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition stands dismissed.
