The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.0093, dated 15.10.2017, registered under Sections 302, 307, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149, 120-B of the IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioners places reliance on the order dated 8.4.2019, passed in CRM-M Nos.16864 and 14744 of 2018 (Annexure P-2) and states that in those cases the accused were granted bail after the testimony of the complainant who has testified that the role of the present petitioners is similar to those accused persons.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from SI Manjit Singh,
has accepted these factual averments.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to take a different view.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
