Prayer made in the instant petition is for regular bail to petitione(s)

Rohit Sharma @ Gora and Rajan Sharma @ Gora in case FIR No.88 dated 26.2.2018 under Sections 379-B, 411, 414 and 201 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that petitioner-Rohit Sharma @ Gora was arrested on 4.3.2018 whereas petitioner-Rajan Sharma @ Gora on 4.4.2018 and the challan stands presented. The case is now fixed for prosecution witness(es). Out of 14 witnesses, only one prosecution witness has been examined so far and the conclusion of the trial will take some time.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of the custody certificate, has submitted that the petitioners are involved in one more case regarding stolen of a property, however, has not disputed that only one prosecution witness has been examined so far.

After hearing counsel for the parties and considering the custody part, this Court finds that the petitioners deserves the concession of regular

bail. Accordingly, the appeal is allowed and the petitioners--Rohit Sharma @ Gora and Rajan Sharma @ Gora are directed to be released on regular bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail of the petitioner, in case he is found involved in any other case or misusing the concession of bail, in any manner.
