TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner assails the seniority list dated 21.02.2018 at Annexure P-3 issued by the Director, Department of Local Government, Punjab of the Sub Fire Officers working with different Municipal Corporations. Further challenge is to the order dated 08.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) vide which private respondent No.4 has been promoted to the post of Fire Station Officer by acting upon the impugned seniority list.

Strangely, the statutory Rules governing the conditions of service of the petitioner as also respondent No.4 have not been placed on record. In other words, the principle governing determination of seniority in the cadre of Sub Fire Officers is not discernible as per pleadings on record. Even during the course of argument, counsel has been unable to advert to the relevant Rules.

Under such circumstances, the prayer and grievance agitated in the instant writ petition cannot be gone into.

Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court afresh by filing a petition with better particulars.
