This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 86 dated 03.06.2018 registered at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda, under Sections 323 and 324 read with section 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added lateron).

Vide order dated 07.09.2018, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Iqbal Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In this view of the matter, the petition is allowed. The order dated 07.09.2018, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
