The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 28.9.2018 passed in CWP No. 10451 of 2017 directing the respondents to regularise the services of the petitioner as per policy dated 1.10.2003 with all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the respondents fairly submits that LPA preferred by the respondents has been dismissed on 10.9.2019. On instructions from Mr. Bhagwan, Range Officer, Bahadurgarh, he seeks eight weeks' time to comply with the directions of this court in case the judgment is either not modified or stayed in legal proceedings. He further submits that the respondents reserve the right to impose conditions to safeguard their interest in case litigation is preferred.

In view of the statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
