This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.153 dated 7.06.2017 under Sections 307,323,506,148,149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana.

Petitioner was granted interim protection vide Order dated 07.09.2018 with a direction to join the investigation. Subsequently, on 30.11.2018, Investigating Officer had informed the Court that although the petitioner had joined the investigation, however, he had not got recovered the alleged weapon of offence used by him. Therefore, the case was adjourned with a direction to the petitioner to join the investigation once again. Thereafter, the case was again adjourned twice, at the request of counsel for the petitioner. However, on 06.03.2019, again the Court was informed by the Investigating Officer that the petitioner had not co-operated in the investigation. Despite that, vide Order dated 06.03.2019, the case

was once again adjourned with a direction to the petitioner to join the investigation and to co-operate with the Investigating Officer.

However, today again learned counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI Gurdeep Singh, submits that the petitioner has not joined the investigation, nor the weapon of offence has been got recovered by him.

On the other hand, Counsel for the petitioner also submits that the petitioner has not contacted them for past quite some time. Hence, there are no latest instructions from the petitioner.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue the interim protection.

Dismissed.
