The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.7, dated 27.1.2017, registered under Sections 302/34 of the IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that it was a blind murder case and no body was named in the FIR.

On 25.10.2018, the following order was passed :-

“ Application for regular bail would be considered after examination of complainant.
List this matter on 05.02.2019.”

Today, counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a copy of the deposition of the complainant where the complainant has turned hostile.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Nishan Singh,

has accepted that the complainant has turned hostile. In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
