The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 19.03.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No.7573 of 2019.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced as under:-

“On the asking of court, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Addl. A.G. Punjab, who is present in court, accepts notice on behalf of official respondent(s). She submits that appropriate authority shall consider the application/representation and take appropriate decision within two weeks. Copy thereof shall be conveyed to the petitioner.”

Ropar annexing order dated 16.05.2019 has been filed today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. The claim of the petitioner has been rejected

In view of reply filed, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against order passed.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
