Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.65 dated 10.04.2019 under Section 61/1/14 of the Excise Act and Sections 9, 39, 50, 51 of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.
