On 25.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“It has been pleaded in the petition that the dispute between the parties is of civil nature as the petitioner had entered into an agreement to sell and also executed a registered Will apart from letter of delivery of possession of the property agreed to be sold.

Notice of motion for 13.05.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner in this

case has already joined the investigation and he is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 25.04.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
