This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0058 dated 09.06.2018, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is on interim bail for about one year, vide order dated 13.09.2018 and he has not misused the concession of interim bail and is facing trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial is likely to take a long time.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Major Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submitted that charges have already been framed and the petitioner is facing trial.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the order dated 13.09.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
