The present writ petition has been filed under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (for short, “the 2005 Act”), challenging the order dated 26.09.2018 (Annexure P-7) passed by the State Information Commission, Haryana, order dated 13.06.2018 (Annexure P-6) passed by the first Appellate Authority-cum-Director Health Services (Dental), Office of the Director General Health Services, Haryana, order dated 22.12.2017 (Annexure P-2) whereby the information as sought for by the applicant (petitioner herein) through his application dated 18.08.2017 (Annexure P-1) regarding personal information of one Smt.Manju wife of Santosh working as a Staff Nurse in Hospital Nangal Chaudhary has been declined in the light of the provisions of Section 8(1)(j) of the 2005 Act.

Perusal of the application dated 18.08.2017 (Annexure P-1),
which has been filed by the petitioner, would indicate that he had sought

personal information of Smt.Manju wife of Santosh. The said document would fall within the ambit of Section 8(1)(j) of the 2005 Act which bars supplying information under the 2005 Act. The orders, as passed by the authorities, which have been impugned herein, cannot be said to be not in accordance with law.

The writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
