In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that respondents No. 3 and 4 filed complaint against him in respect of some allegations, which are being enquired by respondent No. 2. Counsel for the petitioner contends that respondents No. 3 and 4 want to linger on the matter and are not appearing before the authorities as and when they are asked for personal hearing and in this manner petitioner is being harassed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already clarified his position/stand in respect of the complaint by filing a detailed reply dated 26.09.2018, a copy of which has already been attached as Annexure P-6 with the present writ petition. Learned counsel prays that the proceeding in respect of the said complaint be ordered to be finalized at the earliest so that the petitioner is not harassed after his retirement any

further.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take an appropriate decision on the complaint filed by respondents No. 3 and 4, by taking into consideration the reply filed by the petitioner dated 26.09.2018 (Annexure P-6) with the writ petition by following due procedure, within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
