This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for taking action against respondent No.5 in accordance with law and for initiating contempt of Court proceedings against him as he got a favourable order in his favour dated 27.8.2013 Annexure P-14 by concealing the facts, and for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 not to take any cognizance and not to call the petitioner to the police station, City Hoshiarpur.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Digvijay, Kapil, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, City Hoshiarpur, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4. It has been pointed out in the reply that the police inquired into the matter and found that the allegations levelled by respondent No.5 were only of dispute of civil nature. Therefore, the said complaint lodged by respondent No.5 was filed.

In the reply filed by the State, it has also been pointed out that the authorities had also considered the complaint made by respondent No.5; on an order passed by this Court. As directed by this Court, the matter was inquired into and was found not having any substance. Hence, the same was

again filed. Accordingly, no legal action was initiated against the petitioner on the alleged false complaint of the respondent No.5.

In view of the above present petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as such.
