Petitioner prays for regular bail in FIR No.141 dated 15.12.2018 under Sections 341/323/34 IPC (Section 307 IPC was added later on) registered at Police Station Phool, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that he has no objection to grant of regular bail to the petitioner as the parties have settled their dispute.

Learned counsel for the State has informed the Court that the petitioner is in custody for the last more than 2 ½ months and challan has been presented on 29.04.2019.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the facts that trial of the case is likely to take time and complainant is alleged to have settled the matter, therefore, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.

Petition stands disposed of.
