Learned counsel for the complainant has made statement that as per instructions received by him, the complainant does not objects to allowing the present anticipatory bail to which even the learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ram Bhajan, Police Station Taragarh, Pathankot, do not object and states that the petitioner has already joined the investigation in consequence of order dated 10.09.2018 and nothing is to be

recovered from him.

In light of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.09.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

However, in light of the request of the learned counsel for the complainant, the learned Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
