Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and other family members and to take necessary action against respondent Nos.4 to 12, who are threatening the petitioner to implicate her in false and frivolous case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that after granting anticipatory bail, respondent Nos.6 to 12 have again started harassing the petitioner on the ground that since they have taken bail, she cannot do anything against the accused.

Since the anticipatory bail is already under consideration, the State would be at liberty to argue this issue at that time.

No ground to issue any directions is made out.

Dismissed.
