Report dated 25.9.2019 of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad has been received after recording statements of accused Deepak Pandey as well as complainant Mansa Kumari and the learned court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is an outcome of voluntariness, free will and without any coercion or undue pressure. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and in view of the fact that it is a pure matrimonial dispute and compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences and for

betterment of their future life and more-so the offences for which the accused have been booked are not of very serious nature and in view of the law laid down in **Gian Singh vs State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and in view of which the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 61 dated 15.11.2018 under sections 323,506, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Dhauj, District Faridabad and all consequences arising thereof are quashed, qua the present petitioner.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
