The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.266 dated 1.8.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 376 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana.

Heard.

The petitioner and the prosecutrix are present in Court. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has today filed an affidavit of the prosecutrix wherein she has stated that she has married with the petitioner and both are residing together as husband and wife. The affidavit is taken on record.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 22.10.2018 is

terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
