ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.RC221/2017/E0022 dated 16.11.2017, under Section 120-B read with Section 420 Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station CBI/EOU-VII/EO-III, New Delhi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations are primarily against the husband and sons of the petitioner. It is alleged that the value of the property, which was forged for obtaining loan, had been inflated in connivance with the valuers including officials of the bank. The petitioner is 55 years old lady and not involved in any other case.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 10.09.2018, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for CBI states that he has received a telephonic instruction that the petitioner has joined investigation and at present she is not required for custodial interrogation. However, she should cooperate in the investigation and report to the investigating officer as and when called upon to do so.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 55 years old lady, she is not involved in any other case and has joined investigation, the order dated 10.09.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
