Today, pursuant to previous orders passed, learned counsel for the complainant submits that the complainant has received the entire money as was due from the petitioner and has no further grievance left.

The complainant, Nisha, wife of Onkar Singh, who is present in Court, identified by her counsel, has also stated in Court that she has received the entire money as was due from the petitioner and that she has no grievance left against the petitioner.
