Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh Police Station City Kapurthala submits that in consequence of interim order dated 10.09.2018, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and that a settlement has been effected between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, copy of which has been placed on record.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.09.2018 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2)

Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

At this stage, on joint request of the counsel for the parties a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- which was deposited by the husband/petitioner is ordered to be released to the wife on due identification and proper receipt as per law.
