AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 and 5. Counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner No.1 was already married and got her first marriage dissolved by written deed of Mubarat under the title as “ Mutual Divorce by way of Mubarat” from her first husband.

2. Now they have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her

date of birth is mentioned as 31.3.1991 and petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 20.4.1994. They have also moved a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Jind (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

3. Notice of motion qua respondents No. 1 to 3 at this stage.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and a copy of paper-book has been supplied to him.

5. Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and validity of marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Superintendent of Police, Jind to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

6. Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
