1. The grievance of the petitioner is that her husband, who was working as Watchman with respondents, had died in harness on 11.03.202 and she is entitled to be appointed on compassionate grounds, as per applicable policies to the respondents. But, her claim for compassionate appointment has not been considered by the respondents. In the premise, the petitioner also caused legal notice dated 20.12.2013(Annexure P-8), followed by subsequent legal notice dated 26.02.2019(Annexure P-10), but the same were not adverted by the respondents.

2. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 26.02.2019 (Annexure P-10) and also by keeping in view the contentions raised in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

- 4. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
- 5. Disposed of in above terms.
