This order shall dispose of nine contempt petitions bearing COCP Nos.1588, 1589, 1590, 1591, 1592, 1600, 1601, 1602 and 1603 of 2019 as common question of law and facts are involved therein.

All the contempt petitions are filed for non-compliance of order dated 06.02.2019, vide which, direction was issued to consider the matter in the light of orders dated 30.10.2018 and 13.09.2018 passed in various writ petitions. The leading case is CWP No.15922 of 2017.

Mr. P.S. Bajwa, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, present in the Court, has handed over copy of order dated 22.04.2019 passed in CM No.5683 of 2019 in CWP No.15922 of 2017, vide which, application filed by the respondents seeking extension of another four weeks' time to comply with the undertaking was allowed and accordingly another four weeks' time is granted by learned Single Bench to comply with the undertaking.

Thus, in view of the same, as on date, no contempt can be said to be made out. Accordingly the same are dismissed.

However, it is clarified that in case the said orders are not complied within the extended time, the petitioners will be at liberty to revive the present contempt petitions.
