Present petition is for under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.623 dated 24.12.2018 under Section 136 of Electricity Act, 2003, registered at Police Station Thanesar Sadar, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that the petitioners are in custody since 15.01.2019 and they have been falsely implicated in this case. The offence alleged against the present petitioners are triable by the Court of Magistrate. Trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioners behind the bar any more. So, they be released on bail.

Learned State counsel opposed the bail application on the ground that the petitioners are involved in four more cases of similar nature

and counsel for the petitioners contended that the they have already been released on bail in all other cases.

Having considered the submission made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioners are in custody since 15.01.2019. The offence alleged against the present petitioners are triable by the Court of Magistrate; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioners behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
