Pursuant to the order dated 30.09.2019, the report of the learned Mediator in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court dated 08.11.2019, is on record, stating that the parties to the dispute have reached an amicable settlement with each other.

The terms of the settlement have also been annexed along with the report.

It is seen therefrom that the petitioners are to pay different amounts on different dates between 13.11.2019 to 25.07.2021.

On the first date mentioned in the settlement, i.e. 13.11.2019, the petitioners were to pay to the complainant a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/-.

The complainant, Bhupinder Singh, is present in person and has produced his Aadhar card by way of identification, showing him to be the aforesaid person, son of Pritam Singh, resident of Mohalla Daula Nangal, Near Nehru Gate, Batala, Gurdaspur, Punjab.

Counsel for the petitioner has produced in Court today a demand draft dated 13.11.2019, for an amount of Rs. 1,00,000/-, drawn in favour of Bhupinder Singh, which the complainant, after expressing initial reluctance, has eventually accepted.

Consequently, these petitions are disposed of, with the orders dated 10.09.2018 in CRM-M-39473-2018 and 01.11.2018 in CRM-M-48822-2018, admitting the petitioners to anticipatory bail, made absolute. However, liberty is given to the complainant to file an appropriate application in case there is any default at any stage, qua the money to be paid by the petitioners to the complainant, in terms of the settlement reached between them before the learned Mediator on 08.11.2019.
