Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Chamkaur Singh Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga submits that in consequence of interim order dated 13.10.2017, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and does not oppose the grant of bail though on behalf of the complainant Mr. A.S. Brar, Advocate has sought to oppose the same.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 13.10.2017 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
