Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.09 dated 28.01.2019, registered at Police Station Sri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 304, 452, 420, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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Allegation against the present petitioner alongwith one co-accused is that they have gone to the house of complainant and threatened to kill him if he demanded his money and also abused Joginder Singh, father of the complainant. During altercation, father of the complainant suffered a brain stroke and fell down. After some days, he died.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 30.04.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. She is not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending her to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 30.04.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
