The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.7 dated 7.4.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 376 of Indian Penal Code, (Sections 376-D, 292, 34 IPC and Section 67 of Information & Technology Act added later on) at Police Station Dhar Kalan, District Pathankot.

Heard.

Serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner and his associates with regard to commission of rape. A specific role has been attributed to the petitioner in the FIR. Apart from it, he is a proclaimed offender.

Keeping in view the above and seriousness of the allegations, the petitioner is not entitled to the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Dismissed.
