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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 86 dated 03.06.2018 registered at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda, under Sections 323 and 324 read with section 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added lateron).

This is a case of road rage. The petitioner- Urinder Singh @ Kala is alleged to have caused injuries on the right wrist of the complainant, which are grievous in nature.

Vide orders dated 06.10.2018 qua petitioner no.1 Urinder Singh alias Kala and 11.09.2018 qua petitioner no.2 Simran Kaur, both of them were granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Iqbal Singh states that both the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

As recorded in the order dated 06.10.2018 learned counsel for the petitioners had sought time to seek instructions regarding payment of some compensation to the complainant by petitioner no.1. Learned counsel

states that petitioner No.1 is a poor person and he is earning his livelihood by working in Jagratas' parties. At the most, he would be in a position to pay an amount of Rs.5000/-.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petition is allowed. The order dated 06.10.2018, granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner no.1 Urinder Singh @ Kala is made absolute subject to petitioner no.1 paying an amount of Rs.5000/- to the complainant within a period of one week from today. The order dated 11.09.2018 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner no.2 Simran Kaur is also made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
