ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 558, dated 31.8.2017, under Sections 186, 353, 307, 115, 120-B IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station City Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he has fired in the air but no one was injured in the incident. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 1 year and 7 months since his arrest on 31.8.2017.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balwan Singh, states that 6 out of 34 prosecution witnesses have been examined and the petitioner is also involved in other cases.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, contends that the petitioner is on bail in other cases. He also contends that his co-accused

Srikant @ Kanta has already been granted bail by a coordinate Bench of

this Court in CRM-M-20101 of 2018 on 19.11.2018.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when no injury has been caused in the incident, petitioner is in custody for over 1 year 7 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, he is entitled to the concession of regular bail.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Deepak is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, in case the petitioner tries to misuse the concession of bail in any manner, the State shall be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of his bail before this Court.
