Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.144 dated 18.03.2013, under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ballabhgarh City, District Faridabad along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from S.I. Anand Pal, has apprised this Court that after conclusion of the trial, the petitioner was convicted and imposed a fine of ₹ 200/- by learned trial Court, vide order dated 06.12.2018.

In view of above, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner is aggrieved against the order dated 06.12.2018, passed by learned trial Court, he would be at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.
