This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.57 dated 28.06.2011 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Roopnagar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 08.02.2012.

Vide order dated 11.05.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, for getting their statements recorded; as to the genuineness of the compromise. In compliance thereof, report of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sri Anandpur Sahib, dated 18.07.2017, has been received, wherein, it has been reported that the accused has not made the payments as per the

terms of the compromise accordingly the compromise could not be matured between the parties.

In view of the above, this court does not find any reason to continue with the present petition or to pass any further order. Therefore, the petition is hereby dismissed.
