The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.381, dated 23.03.2019, under Sections 20/61/85 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Jagadhari, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that 2 kg of *ganja patti* has been allegedly recovered from the petitioner which is way below the threshold of commercial quantity of 20 kg. The petitioner is 65 years of age and is not involved in any other case. He is in custody since 23.02.2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Janak, states that investigation has been completed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, alleged recovery is of non-commercial quantity, petitioner is not involved in any other case, investigation having been completed and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
