Upon a call given by Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana High Court, the lawyers are abstaining from putting in appearance.

When the case was called, the petitioners have appeared in person and insisted for adjudication of this case today itself.

This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions for protection of their life and liberty as they apprehending threat at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Petitioner No.1 has fairly stated that the parents are not even aware of the alleged marriage entered into between the petitioners on 23.04.2019. She further concedes that her affair with petitioner No.2 is approximately 2 years old and the same was disclosed to her father a year back. However, it is conceded by her that previously she never made any complaint against her parents. She also fairly states that they have no threat to the alleged marriage. Petitioners filed this petition only to counter the possibility of registration of case at the instance of respondent No.4.

The pleadings and the stand before the Court are completely conflicting and the representation also does not mention the fact that parents were informed about the alleged marriage. Therefore, no convincing ground is made out for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Resultantly, the petition stands dismissed.
