ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.31 dated 20.03.2019 under Sections 307, 452, 323, 429, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 11 (1) of the Prevention of Cruelty to the Animals Act, 1960 registered at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that she had hit the father of the complainant over his right eye with a brick bat. He also contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case as the quarrel had taken place between her son and the son of the complainant. He further contends that the injured has fully recovered. She is 45 years of age and is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 29.04.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 29.04.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
