The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.45, dated 3.2.2017, registered under Sections 406, 420 of the IPC, at Police Station Kundli, District Sonapat.

As per allegations, the petitioner and her husband were co-owners of a plot measuring 800 sq. yards where they were running a paper industry. The said plot was mortgaged with the Punjab National Bank but despite that the petitioner and her husband sold the said plot. On the previous date, the precise argument raised by counsel for the petitioner was that even though the petitioner may have been a co-signatory to the documents but the entire control was with her husband, and he had stated that the husband would surrender, and further that custodial interrogation of

the petitioner was not required since the case was entirely based on documentary evidence. Counsel for the petitioner states that husband of the petitioner has surrendered and is in custody.

Learned AAG Haryana, on instructions from SI Davinder Kumar, has accepted the factual assertions that the husband of the petitioner has surrendered and that the entire case is based on documentary evidence.

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to permit custodial interrogation of the petitioner. Resultantly, this petition is allowed and it is directed that in the event of her arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
