Prayer in the petition is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.24 dated 05.02.2019 registered under Sections 380, 457 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Ratia, Tehsil Ratia, District Fatehabad.

On 02.05.2019, following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 09.04.2019 passed by this court in the case of co-accused. Petitioner also claims parity.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Raj Kumar Makkar, Sr. DAG, Haryana, who is present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned

counsel for the State during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Gurpal Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 02.05.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
