1. The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.56 dated 5.2.2019 under Section 148, 149, 307, 506 IPC and Section 3(2)(v) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act and Sections 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Safidon, District Jind.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case in fact a case of cross-versions, where the petitioner had himself received firearm injuries at the hands of Sagar.
3. The aforestated position is not disputed by learned State counsel. It has also not been disputed that both the parties belong to Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes community. It has been informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated

14.5.2019, the petitioner has since joined investigation.

4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and bearing in mind that it is a case of cross-version, I do not find that it to be a case of custodial interrogation. Accordingly the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued vide dated 14.5.2019 by this Court are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner would appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
