The prayer herein is for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to regularize the services of the petitioner as Clerk-cum-Computer Operator in accordance with the provisions of Punjab Adhoc, Contracual, Daily Wage, Temporary, Work Charged and Out Sourced Welfare Act, 2016(for brevity, Welfare Act, 2016) .

The petitioner is serving respondent No.3 since 2005. Her grievance is that respondent No.3 passed resolution dated 07.07.2010 (Annexure P-8) to regularize her services, but still the benefit of regularization has not been discriminately granted to her as the other other similarly situated employees services have been regularized. It is further the case of the petitioner that she has been deprived of benevolent provisions contained in Welfare Act, 2016. She made representations dated 05.04.2018 and 06.12.2018(Annexures P-15 and P-16 respectively), but the same have not been adverted to by the respondent No.3.

Given the nature of order being passed, no further proceedings or pleadings are required.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the representations (Annexure P-15 & P-16) and by treating the writ petition as supplementary representation and decide the same by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
