The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.55 dated 21.05.2018, registered under Sections 363, 366, 376, 120-B IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

The statement of prosecutrix was recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. by the learned Magistrate on 22.05.2018 wherein she has stated that she was raped by the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the copy of the birth certificate of the prosecutrix wherein her date of birth has been mentioned as 11.06.2000 but this certificate was registered and issued on 08.06.2018.

However, to the contrary, learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that as per 'Adhar' card and the age proof submitted alongwith protection petition, the date of birth of the prosecutrix is 03.05.2000.

Heard. The serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner. As such, this court does not find any ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
