1. Petitioner-Neha had submitted an application to Hon'ble the Chief Justice, alleging that her husband Sanjeet Kumar had been illegally detained by the police officials of Division No.6, Ludhiana. The said application was ordered to be treated as Criminal Writ Petition and was listed before this Court.
2. Vide order dated 26.4.2019, it had been directed that a Warrant Officer be appointed to raid Police Station Division No.6, Ludhiana, and in case the alleged detenue is found to be illegally detained there, then to secure his release immediately.
3. Pursuant to the aforesaid directions, a Warrant Officer went to Police Station Division No.6, Ludhiana, on 26.4.2019, but despite having

conducted a search of the police station, the alleged detainee was nowhere found in the police station. The Warrant Officer also tried to contact Smt. Neha on her Mobile Phone bearing No.80540-84493, as had been disclosed in her application but the said phone number was stated to be “switched off”.

4. In view of the aforesaid report, no further direction is required to be issued.
5. The petition, as such, is disposed of.
