The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.302 dated 20.10.2015, registered under Sections 363, 366(A), 376, 506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

No active role has been given to the petitioner. Now the victim as well as Jaskaran Singh had married. This court has already been granted the benefit of anticipatory bail to Jagroop Kaur in *CRM-M-2875-2016*. However, learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 13.09.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
