The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 53 dated 02.02.2016, under Section 120-B, 166, 167, 193, 195, 196, 218, 219, 220, 230, 330, 342, 365, 489-A, 489-B of the IPC and Sections 17/61/85 of the NDPS Act and SC/ST Act, registered at Police Station Punhana, District Mewat.

The operative part of the order dated 05.04.2018, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that since the order declaring the petitioners as proclaimed persons has been set-aside vide order of even date passed in CRM-M No.10774 of 2018, the petitioners be now released on interim anticipatory bail. Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rajpal Singh, submits that the petitioners be directed to join the investigation.

List again on 25.07.2018.”

ASI Sunil Kumar, who is present in Court, submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 05.04.2018, have already joined investigation and they are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 05.04.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
